Schuyler County Legislator, Mark Rondinaro spoke about sales tax. He stated July was up 12.55% above the previous year. The first payment in August is up \$85,312.86 for the first payment which is 11.05% up from last year. To date the 2018 year is up \$559,717.62 which is 8.87% above last year.
